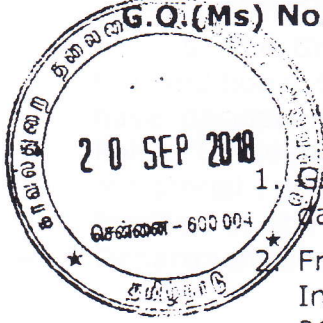

1. G.O.(Ms)No.421, Home (Police-17) Department, dated 08.06.2012.
2. From the Additional Director General of Police/ Inspector General of Prisons Letter No.15774/EW.2/ 2012, dated 29.10.2013 and 15.06.2018.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have extended the facilities of Canteens formed for Police personnel to the benefit of both serving and retired Executive Prison personnel and their families and families of the deceased Executive Prison personnel on par with Police personnel.

2. The Hon'ble Minister for Law, Courts and Prisons, while moving the Demand of the Prison Department for the year 2018-2019 on the Floor of the Assembly on 05.06.2018, has made the following announcement among others:-

3. The Additional Director General of Police/ Inspector General of Prisons in his proposal second read above has stated that, the Prison Ministerial Staff are equal to the Ministerial Staff of the Police Department as both are discharging similar duties and responsibilities and the facilities of purchasing articles from the Police Canteens at subsidized rates are not provided to the Prison Ministerial staff. He has also stated that the Tamil Nadu Prison Department Ministerial Staff

have represented to extend the facilities of Tamil Nadu Police Canteen to the Prison Ministerial Staff and Miscellaneous Staff also on par with Tamil Nadu Police personnel.

4. The Additional Director General of Police/ Inspector General of Prisons has, therefore, requested the Government to extend the facilities of purchasing articles from the Police Canteens at subsidized rates to all the serving and retired Ministerial / Miscellaneous staff of Prison Department and also to the families of the deceased, on par with the Ministerial staff of Police Department.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Director General of Police/Inspector General of Prisons have decided to extend the facilities of purchasing articles from the Police Canteens at subsidized rates, to all the serving and retired Ministerial / Miscellaneous staff of Prison Department and also to the families of the deceased, on par with the Ministerial staff of Police Department and issue order accordingly.
