ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government accorded administrative sanction for the establishment of "Retired Police Personnel Welfare Board".

2. In the letter second read above, the Government permitted the Director General of Police & Head of Police Force to constitute the Temporary Committees at District and City level for the purpose of suggesting and formulating the aims, objectives, schemes and by-laws for the ultimate constitution and smooth functioning of the Retired Police Personnel Welfare Board.

3. The Director General of Police in his letter third read above has requested to constitute a Temporary State Level Committee for the Retired Police Personnel Welfare Board to scrutinize the recommendations of the above said temporary committees and to formulate the various welfare measures to be taken up for implementation and to submit the proposal to

the Government for approval and for the framing of the draft-by-laws etc. as detailed below:-

Sl. No.	Name of the Office bearer in the Temporary State Level Committee	Designation of the Officer who is appointed in Ex-officio capacity in the Temporary State Level Committee
1.	Chief Patron	The Director-General of Police & Head of Police Force, Tamil Nadu.
2.	Director	The Additional Director-General of Police, Welfare, Tamil Nadu.
3.	Joint Director	The Inspector-General of Police (Welfare), Tamil Nadu.
4.	Deputy Director	The Assistant Inspector-General of Police (Welfare), Tamil Nadu.
5.	Honorary Members	<p>i. Any suitable officer from the <u>Home Department</u> to be nominated by the Government.</p> <p>ii. The Additional Secretary to Government, Finance Department, who is working as <u>Financial Controller</u> in the Office of the Director-General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, to be nominated by the <u>Finance Department</u>.</p> <p>iii. <u>Three Retired Officers</u> (minimum <u>One Woman Officer</u>) not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police to be appointed by the Director-General of Police, Tamil Nadu.</p>

The Director General of Police has suggested that the following three Retired Police Officers may be nominated as Honorary Members of the Board:-

- i. Thiru. R. Chinnaraj, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Retired), Chennai;
- ii. Thiru. N. Dhamodaran, Superintendent of Police (Retired), Chennai; and
- iii. Thiru. K. N. Murali, Additional Superintendent of Police (Retired), Chennai.

The Director-General of Police has also stated that retired women police officers did not come forward eagerly to be as one of the members. He has therefore suggested that the Director General of Police/Head of Police Force, Tamil Nadu may be authorized to nominate a serving women police officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police to the state level temporary committee for the Retired Police Personnel Welfare Board as and when required.

4. The Government after detailed examination of the proposal of the Director General of Police have decided to accept it and nominate Tmt.T.Vaidegi, Additional Secretary to Government as Honorary Member to the said Committee. Accordingly, the Government permit the Director General of Police to constitute the State Level Temporary Committee for the Retired Police Personnel Welfare Board, subject to the following conditions:-

- a. No funds will be sanctioned to commence the functioning of the above said Temporary Committees;
- b. The Temporary State Level Committee should be disbanded after the purpose for its formation is over, as it is formed purely on temporary basis;
- c. No honorarium will be paid to the Retired Police Officers, who are to be nominated in the above said Committees and their participation should be free of cost; and
- d. No logistical support will be provided to the Members of the committee.
