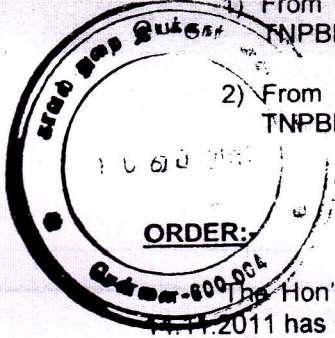

The Hon'ble Chief Minister, during the Police Officer's Conference held on 14.11.2011 has made the following announcement:-

"At present, the wards of Police Personnel are granted scholarship up to Rs.20,000/- per year from the Tamil Nadu Police Benevolence Fund. Henceforth, the hostel fees will also be allowed raising the amount to Rs.25,000/-".

2. The Director General of Police in his letters read above, has sent a proposal to Government wherein he has stated that during April 1957 Tamil Nadu Police Benevolent Fund was constituted for the benefit of Non-Gazetted staff of Police Department and during March 1994, orders were issued for the creation of "Dr. J Jayalalitha Special Scholarship for the Children of Police personnel" for the most outstanding children of the Police Personnel from the rank of Police Constables to Inspectors of Police of the entire Police Department entering professional institutions, with one Scholarship of Rs.40,000/- for the best student and 5 Scholarship of Rs.20,000/- each to the outstanding students every year. sanction a sum of Rs.6.00 lakhs (Rupees six lakhs only) towards contribution of State Government's share to this scholarship fund. The Director General of Police is requested to deposit the amount volunteered by the Special Security Group personnel amounting to Rs.4.00 lakhs and the Government contribution of Rs.6.00 lakhs totaling Rs.10.00 lakhs in any one of the approved financial institutions like the Tamil Nadu Transport Development Finance Corporation or any one of the Nationalized Banks and Utilize the interest amount accrued from the above deposit for the grant of the above scholarships.

3. The Director General of Police has also stated that during August 1997 amendments were issued to the effect that "Dr. J Jayalalitha Special Scholarship for the Children of Police personnel" shall be known as "Chief Ministers Special Scholarship Fund". Subsequently, different Government orders have been issued in this regard. Based on the recommendation of the Third Police Commission among other things, the following orders were issued:-

- (i) The Government grant of Rs.50 lakhs which was earlier sanctioned has been enhanced as Rs.1 Crore.
- (ii) Scholarship to pursue higher education in which the first 100 wards who had secured highest marks in +2 standard will be paid Rs.20,000/- or the tuition fees paid to the institutions whichever is less till they complete their higher studies.

4. The Director General of Police has further stated that 100 students are awarded Special Scholarship in a year, the extra amount required per year for 100 students is Rs.5,00,000/- (Rs.5,000 X 100). The Scholarship has to be awarded for four years, four sets of 100 students, (1st year, 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year) have to be given the amount. Therefore, the total additional requirement per year is Rs.20,00,000/-.

5. The Director General of Police has therefore requested the Government to increase the total grant from Rs.1 Crore to Rs.1.2 Crore every year referred to at para 4 above to implement the announcement of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu.

6. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director General of Police, Chennai in para 5 above. Accordingly, sanction is accorded for increase of grant from Rs.1 Crore to Rs.1.2 Crore every year so as to sanction Special Scholarship amount paid to the wards of Police Personnel from Rs.20,000/- to Rs.25,000/- which includes hostel fees.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2055 - 00 - Police -113 Welfare of the Police Personnel -
I Non Plan - AC - Assistance to Police Welfare - 10 -
Contributions - 01 - Contribution to Specific Fund".
(DPC 2055 - 00 - 113 - AC -1016).

8. The expenditure sanctioned shall constitute item of "New Instrument of Service" The necessary funds will be provided in the Supplementary Estimates
