### ORDER:

While replying to the police demand on 24.08.2011, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced on the floor of Assembly as follows:-

### Announcement No.8

“காவலர்கள் முதல் ஆய்வாளர்களுக்கான காப்பீட்டுத் தொகையினை உயர்த்தி வழங்குதல்:

Enhancement of Insurance amount for Police Personnel up to Inspector of Police.

காவலர்கள் இடர் மிகுந்த பணிகளில் ஈடுபடும் போது அவர்கள் எதிர்பாராது உயிர் இழக்க நேர்ந்தாலோ அல்லது விபத்தின் காரணமாக உடனடியுற்றாலோ அவர்களுக்கு தற்போது காப்பீட்டுத் தொகையாக 1 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் வழங்கப்பட்டு வருகிறது. இந்த காப்பீட்டுத் தொகையினை உயர்த்தி வழங்க இவ்வாறு முடிவு செய்துள்ளது.

காவலர்கள் முதல் ஆய்வாளர்கள் நிலை வரை உள்ள காவல்துறைப் பணியாளர்கள், பணியில் இருக்கும்போது உயிர் இழப்பு ஏற்படாமல், அவர்களுக்கு அல்லது அவர்களது வாரிசுகளார்களுக்கு காப்பீட்டுத் திட்டத்தின் கீழ் தற்போது வழங்கும் இம் காப்பீட்டுத் தொகை 1 இலட்சம் ரூபாயிலிருந்து 2 இலட்சம் ரூபாயாக உயர்த்தி வழங்கப்படும்.”

2. In the reference third read above the Director General of Police has furnished necessary proposal. The Government after careful consideration have decided to increase the insurance amount from one lakh to Two Lakhs payable to the Police Constables to Inspectors of Police in Police Department who lose their lives while on duty. Accordingly Government hereby sanction a sum of Rs.10

lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) for the financial year 2011-2012 and direct that from 2012-2013 onwards necessary provisions will be made in regular budget.

3. The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2055 - 00 Police 113 Welfare of Police Personnel - I- Non Plan - AI - Corpus Fund for Tamil Nadu Police Officials / Personnel - 10 - Contribution - 01- Contribution to Specific Fund"  
(DPC 2055 00 113 AI 1014)

4. The expenditure is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department will issue. The Director General of Police is directed to send necessary proposals to the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund.

5. The Director General of Police is also directed to send a draft explanatory note, indicating the total cost of the scheme, the cost that would be required for the implementation during the financial year etc. to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the supplementary estimates for bringing it to the notice of the Legislature in due course.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.58542/Home-I/2011, dated 15.11.2011 and Additional sanction ledger No.876 (Eight Hundred and Seventy Six).
